Thank you for trusting me to build a RoadWing for you.

I do not konw what year GL1800 this shock came off. It was removed in working order and that is how I received it. The manual RAP and pre-load are from a Honda ST1300. I sent it assembled but you will need to disassemble it to install it. I suggest removing the line from the RAP side. I filled it with oil so as long you are careful and don't spill any oil when installing it you shojld be good to go. If you spill any oil you can pick up some 5w fork oil. I used Lucas Oil 10771 Fork Oil. You will also need a kids medicine suringe (or something like that) to fill and bleed it. You can tape the end of the hose and be sure to keep the RAP handle down till you reassemble it. Includes used banjo bolts, washers and hose. Visit https://www.jrbk.net/roadwing/preload-raps/ to get an idea of where to mount it on the bike.

The shock, pre-load and manual RAP were inspected and tested when they arrived and prior to shipment. The shock was disassembled (absorber left intact) and cleaned with Yamaclean. The preload assembly was completely disassembled as well. I cleaned it with Yamaclean on the outside and a towl on the inside. I inspected seals and gaskets. I added some grease to the gaskets to keep them soft and working properly. I reassembled it and then tested it before taking pictures and getting it ready to ship. I converted it to a Roadwing using the method described at my website (https://www.jrbk.net/roadwing/roadwing-conversion/). Here is a summary of what was done: A new mounting hole was drilled in the shock arm and the excess was cut off and filed. The original bushing was pressed out from the collar and a new bushing and washers was installed in the collar with parts from McMaster-Carr. I cleaned up the shock when it was disassembled, using Yamaclean and a towel. The spring may have some surface rust but there is no rot and it is fully intact.

It will take some elbow grease to install this on your Road Star. Details on how to mount this shock can be found at https://www.irbk.net/roadwing-install/
